

Continuing Medical Education Credit Hours

The current host institution of MDM, the [University of Illinois at Chicago College of Medicine](#), is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education to provide continuing medical education credit hours for physicians.

CME credit hours are awarded by the UIC College of Medicine for reviews of MDM manuscripts that require multiple reviewers—when the review is of sufficient quality and timeliness, as deemed by the manuscript’s action editor.

MDM manuscript review activity is eligible for a maximum of three Category 1 credit hours toward the American Medical Association Physician’s Recognition Award (AMA PRA Category 1 Credit™). Physicians should claim only the number of credit hours commensurate with the extent of their participation in this activity.

To receive CME credit for an MDM review, reviewers must select the checkbox at the top of the review form that reads: “Check here if you are a physician and would like to receive CME credit for completing this review if editors deem it timely and of high quality” (see below):
